E-Waste: Old TV's, computer monitors, keyboards, printers, phones, processors, small appliances. See the website for a list.



Any CRV container (but does not pay)
Carpet & Carpet Pads
Glass Containers

All glass: colored or clear; CRV or not

Plastic - CRV and #'s 1 & 2 only. Rinse clean
Household Hazardous Waste
 Special collection days only

Mattresses – Fee Required

U-Waste
 Florescent tubes, compact florescent, bulbs, incandescent bulbs, all types of batteries – including household & auto



Motor Oil and oil filters

Woody Materials; Fee required for disposal
 Brush, Prunings, Christmas Trees, Pallets, Slash, Yard Waste, Limbs etc.

Tires – fee required per tire

Newspapers

Brown Paper Bags

Paperboard – cereal boxes, shoe boxes
etc - - remove plastic inner liner

Corrugated cardboard- remove plastic
inner liner



Magazines & Catalogs

CRV plastic, aluminum and glass

HDPE #2 Plastic bottles and jugs



Milk, water, juice, liquid detergent,
shampoos

Milk cartons and juice boxes-rinsed out

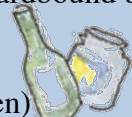
Junk mail - including envelopes

Placed in plastic bags in bins

Paperback Books (not hardbound books)

Steel, tin cans



Colored glass (not broken)
